KEY VERSE

1. THE GOSPEL SAVES US
FROM DEATH TO LIFE, AND
MAKES US HOLY



9 He has saved us and called us to a holy life – not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time.



*10 but it has now been revealed
through the appearing of our Saviour,
Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death
and has brought life and immortality to
light through the gospel.*

2. GUARDING THE GOSPEL

UNASHAMEDLY, IN THE
FACE OF SUFFERING



*11 And of this gospel I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher.
12 That is why I am suffering as I am.*



*'Yet this is no cause for shame,
because I know whom I have believed,
and am convinced that he is able to
guard what I have entrusted to him
until that day.'*



3. GOSPEL MINISTRY NEEDS GOSPEL SUPPORT

16 May the Lord show mercy to the household of Onesiphorus, because he often refreshed me and was not ashamed of my chains. 17 On the contrary, when he was in Rome, he searched hard for me until he found me. 18 May the Lord grant that he will find mercy from the Lord on that day! You know very well in how many ways he helped me in Ephesus.
